Most of the time, cancer happens by chance. However, in some families cancer may be caused, in part, by changes in certain genes that can run in the family. These genetic changes significantly increase a person's risk for certain cancers, including a second cancer in those who have already had cancer. Both you and your family may benefit from this information, since hereditary cancer risk can be significantly reduced with various medical interventions.
